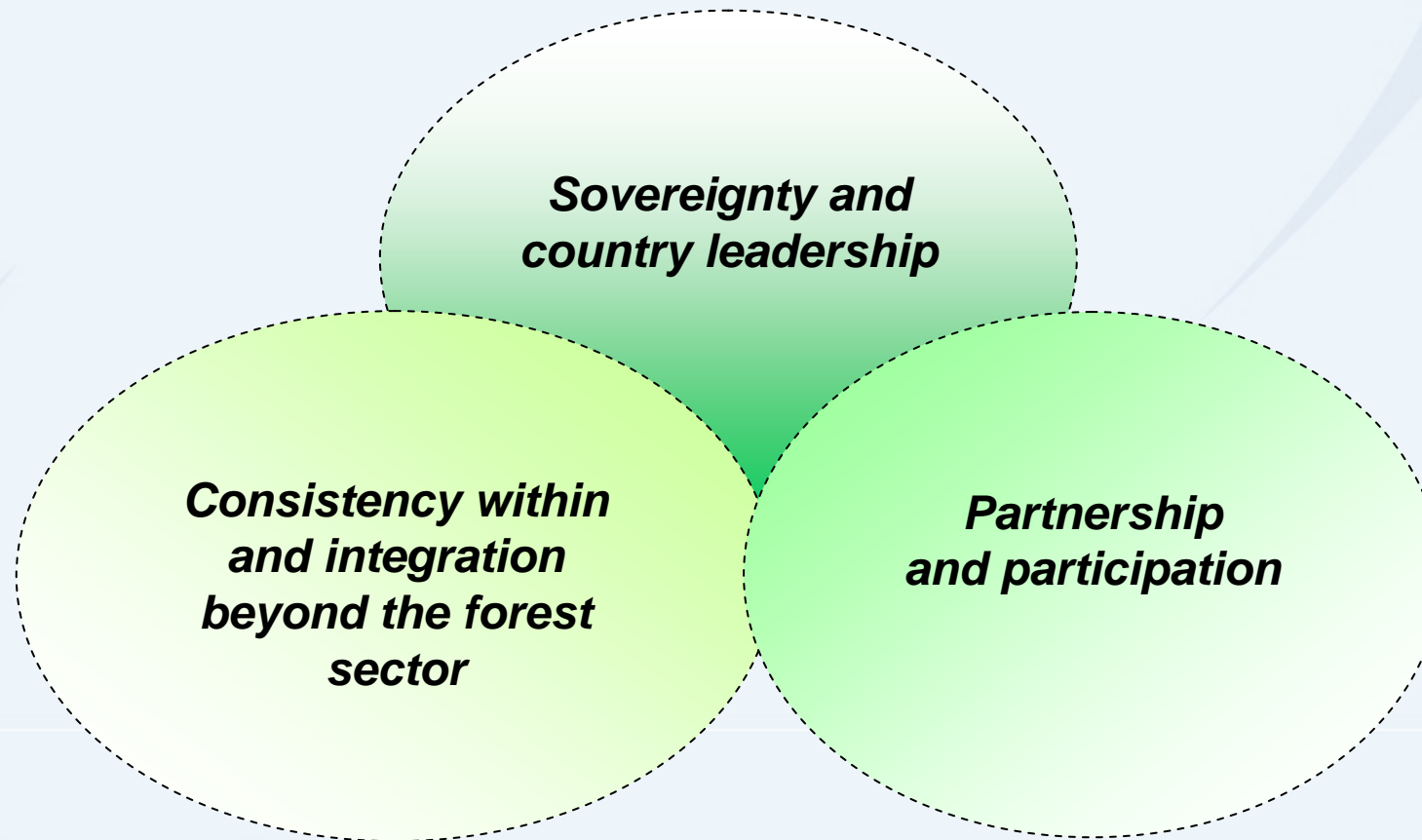

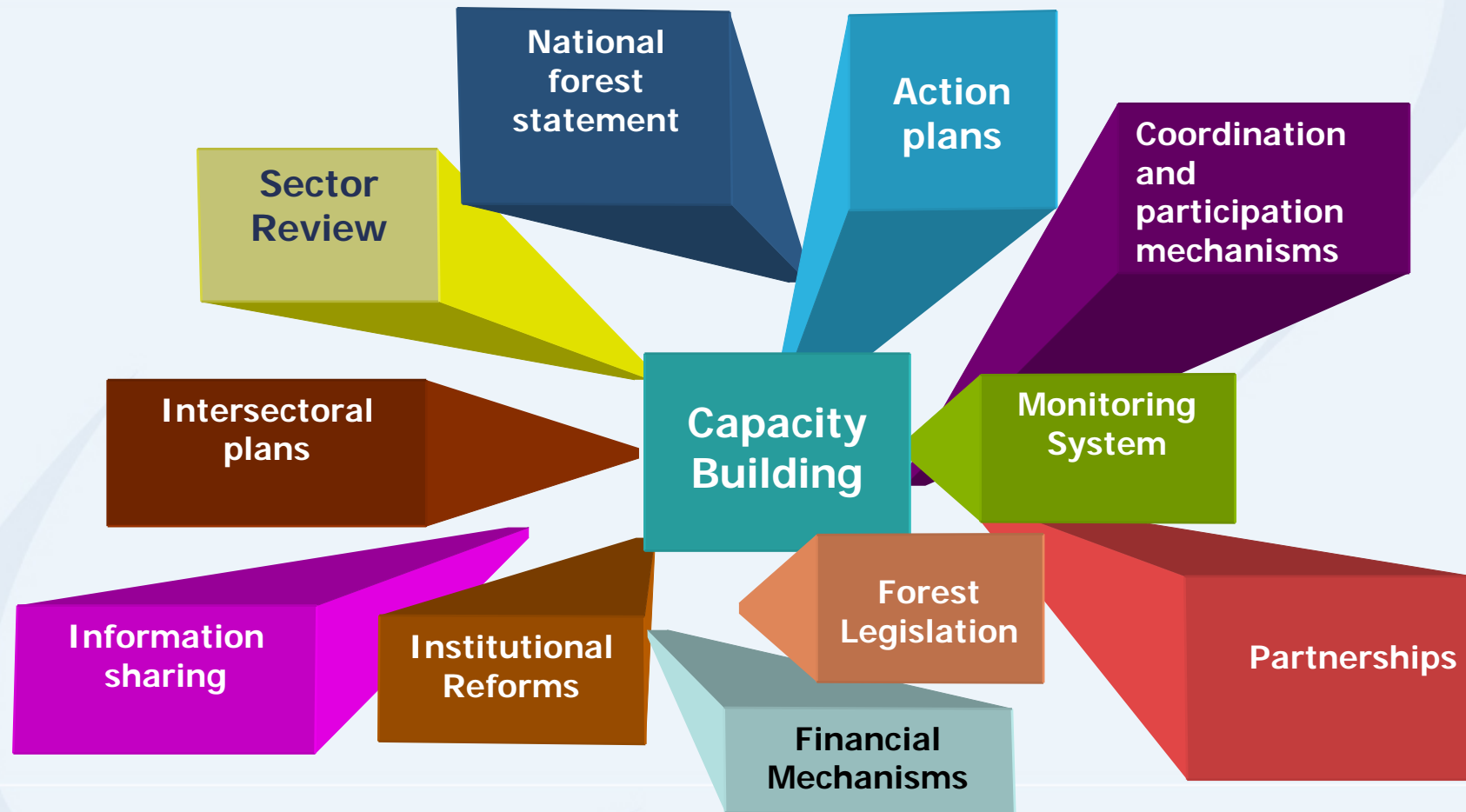

Facility - Strategic orientations

- Integrating **multipurpose** SFM into poverty reduction strategies and broad intersectoral processes (**water, environment, climate change, agriculture, mining, energy, national financing strategies etc.**)
- Developing a consensus on how to address issues relevant to forests at the national level (**FLEG, FLEGT, FCPF, REDD, Financing etc.**)
- Translating commitments at the international level into national forest policy and planning **and vice versa**

Country Priorities - Governance (60%)

- **Building capacity in forest governance** that facilitate and promote sustainable and equitable forest conservation and management,
- **Identify and promote policy, legal, institutional and economic arrangements** that contribute to improved forest governance,
- **Promote and strengthen transparency** in allocation and use of forest resources.
